



23rd ANNUAL LAW ENFORCEMENT TRAINING DAY LOS ANGELES AUTO SHOW

On Tuesday, December 4, 2012, law enforcement vehicle theft investigators and NICB Special Agents will be permitted to enter the Los Angeles Auto Show from 0830 hours to 1100 hours for vehicle identification training. Refreshments will be provided by Toyota and NICB in room 502 A&B on the second floor of the lobby between 0630 and 0830 hours.

Between 0715 and 0800 William Biondo from General Motors Offices in Detroit, MI will put on a presentation on GM Vehicle Labeling.

All officers must enter by 1000 hours. After 1000, no one will be permitted into the convention center. Admission is free; however, there will be a charge for parking.

The training is provided to allow auto theft investigators an opportunity to inspect new vehicle identification numbers, and interact with vehicle manufacturers.
